

CSS Reference Sheet

This is the your guide to CSS code. CSS stands for Cascading Style Sheet and is used for describing how your webpage looks. Basically, they further describe how your different elements and tags (like <p> and <h1>) should look on screen. It determines the font size, color, font type, location, etc. Download and save this document for future reference. You can even copy and paste this code into a blank .html document to get started!

body {	
background-attachment: fixed;	Keeps the background in a fixed position on the page.
background-color: #000000;	Use hexadecimal colors for the background.
background-image: yourimage.jpg;	Use any image for your background.
background-position: bottom left;	Set the starting point of your background.
background-repeat: repeat;	You can make the background image repeat.

borders {	
border-bottom-width: 2px;	Thickness of the bottom border of a HTML tag.
border-left-width: 2px;	Thickness of the left border of a HTML tag.
border-right-width: 2px;	Thickness of the right border of a HTML tag.
border-top-width: 2px;	Thickness of the top border of a HTML tag.
border-width: 2px;	Sets thickness of all borders of HTML tag.
border-color: #ffffff;	Hexadecimal value of border.
clear: left;	Makes it so no floating elements can be on top of it.
color: 999999;	Used to set any element to any hexadecimal color.
cursor: pointer;	Change the cursor when inside the element;

float: right;	Moves element to any side, text wraps around it.
}	
typography {	
font-family: times new roman;	Set font for text.
font-size: 20pt;	Set font size for specific text.
font-style: italic;	Change font to italics or normal.
font-variant: small-caps;	Font's lowercase letters will be smaller capitals.
font-weight: bold;	Change weight of the font: bolder, lighter, normal.
height: 60%;	Sets element's height;
left: 30px;	Sets element's position to the left side of the screen.
letter-spacing: 0.4em;	Defines space between letters (kerning).
word-spacing: 0.4em;	Defines space between words.
line-height: 150%;	Sets space between lines of text within element.
text-align: center;	Aligns text in element;

<pre>text-decoration: underline; }</pre>	Changes look of text: underline, overline, none.
<pre>lists { list-style-image: yourimage.jpg; list-style-type: diamond; margin: 5px; overflow: auto; }</pre>	Set images to be in the bullet point in list. Change the shape of your bullet in list. Changes the margin of element. What if the content is bigger than space.
<pre>padding { padding-bottom: 20px; padding-left: 20px; padding-right: 20px; padding-top: 20px; }</pre>	Changes padding at bottom of element; Changes padding at left of element; Changes padding at right of element; Changes padding at top of element;
<pre>position { position: absolute; visible: hidden; width: 450px; z-index: 4;</pre>	Defines if an element is able to be positioned. Used to make an element invisible or visible. Sets element's width. Used to set elements on top of each other.
